

Certificate Authentication Information

Scope certificates shall now be authenticated through the '<u>Find a Certified Company</u>' page only, which serves as a single source of truth for all scope certificates.

Transaction certificates issued **after** October 1, 2022 shall now be authenticated through our <u>Authenticate a Transaction</u> page **only**, which is our single source of truth for all valid transaction certificates. However, transaction certificates issued **before** October 1, 2022 may still be authenticated by submitting an inquiry with the issuing certification body.
